- [Milan High Alumni Day](#) is held the third weekend of June each year. Hundreds of graduates return for this annual gathering.
- [Milan No Till-Field Day](#) Beginning in 2000, the No-Till Field Day will be held the fourth Thursday of July, every other year at the University of Tennessee Agricultural Experiment Station located in Milan. Thousands of farmers and agribusiness representatives from across the country and around the world attend this event. Associated activities include a fashion show, golf, and other community activities.
- **Gibson County Fair** the oldest county fair in the south, is held in August each year in neighboring Trenton.
- [Fall Folkore Jamboree](#) is held the third Saturday of October with approximately 100 traditional folk artist covering the grounds of the West Tennessee Agricultural Museum. The artisans demonstrate skills in traditional crafts such as broom and soap making, quilting, and doll making. Local groups fill the air with music throughout the day. - [West Tennessee Agricultural Museum](#) located on Ledbetter Gate Road in Milan houses hundreds of farm and farmhouse artifacts. Guided tours are available and admission is free. For information call (731) 686-8067.
